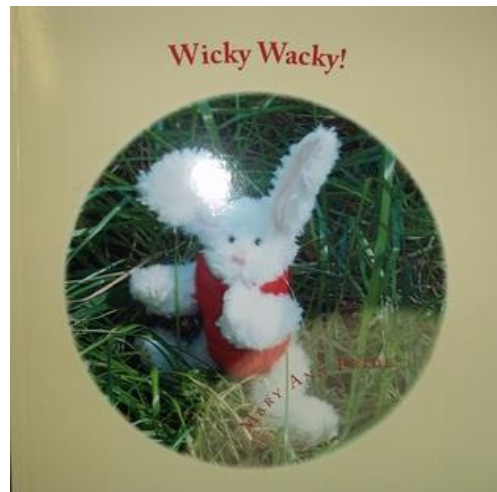
## Activities
