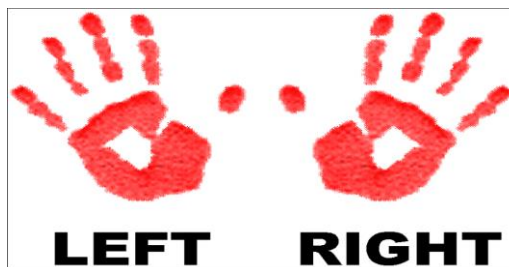
Construction on Barrypoint Rd. will begin May 5 so parking may become an issue. Scottswood Rd., the other street that runs along the church, may be a good parking option.
