We love to play outside, so please dress your children for the cold with hats and mittens. Gloves are very difficult for the kids to put on and time consuming for us to help with so mittens are much better!

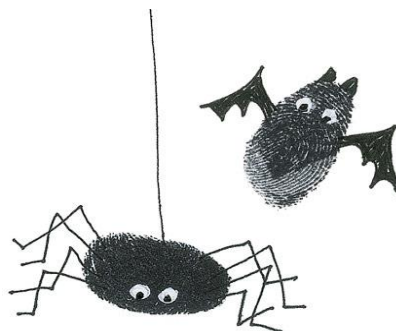
## Activities
